Guidance for Overseas Chinese Students and Foreign Students

The Office of Int'l and Cross-strait Affairs (OICA) offers support for international students, including applications for scholarships and financial assistance, health insurance, residence and work permits, and safety issues. OICA also proactively

cares for students' rights, and provides them with a pleasant learning environment by making use of resources from the administration and expertise of counseling and guidance. NCUE was honored with the Ministry of Education's Award for Excellence in Int'l Student Guidance and Counseling, which recognizes NCUE's effective support for international students.

To facilitate psychological health care services for international students, the Student Psychological Counseling and Guidance Center provides students with group counseling and workshops, one-on-one consultation for mental health, new student orientation, and stress tests, etc.

Professional Credit Programs

In addition to the existing academic interdisciplinary professional programs for students to gain more competitive advantages. They are

Teacher Education Programs

NCUE provides training for high school principals and teachers from different country of residence. There are two ways for overseas Chinese students to enroll in teacher education programs:

- 1. Applying to become a teacher education student: Submit your application to the Center for Teacher Education during the second semester of your first year at NCUE. Qualified applicants granted by MOE will gain a qualification of being teacher education students and be eligible to apply to take the Teacher's Certification Exam and apply for a teaching internship after completing the program.
- 2. Applying to enroll in the program: Overseas Chinese students can apply to enroll in the Teacher Education Program. Admitted applicants that complete the program will be awarded a certificate used for applying for teaching jobs in their country of residence.

The Center for Teacher Education consists of 3 divisions in charge of different services related to teacher training. It works together with 14 teacher education departments to cultivate quality modern high school teachers.



Exchange Students

NCUE partners with nearly 200 universities located in the United States, Australia, France, Germany, Japan, South Korea, the United Kingdom, Mainland China, etc.

Students can exchange to one of the internationally renowned universities to study for six months up to one year at their own expense or without paying tuition fees at the host campus in accordance with the agreement between the two institutions.

Dual Degree Programs

A number of departments at NCUE are in cooperation with partner universities on dual-degree programs, enabling students to gain two degrees within a certain time frame. Currently NCUE has dual-degree programs in Business Administration, Physics, and Guidance and Counseling with California State University, Fresno in the USA; a program in Business Administration with California State University, Sacramento; a program in Accounting with the University of Southern Queensland in Australia; a program in Business Administration with Tohoku University in Japan; and a program in Computer Science and Information Engineering with Kennesaw State University in the USA.




