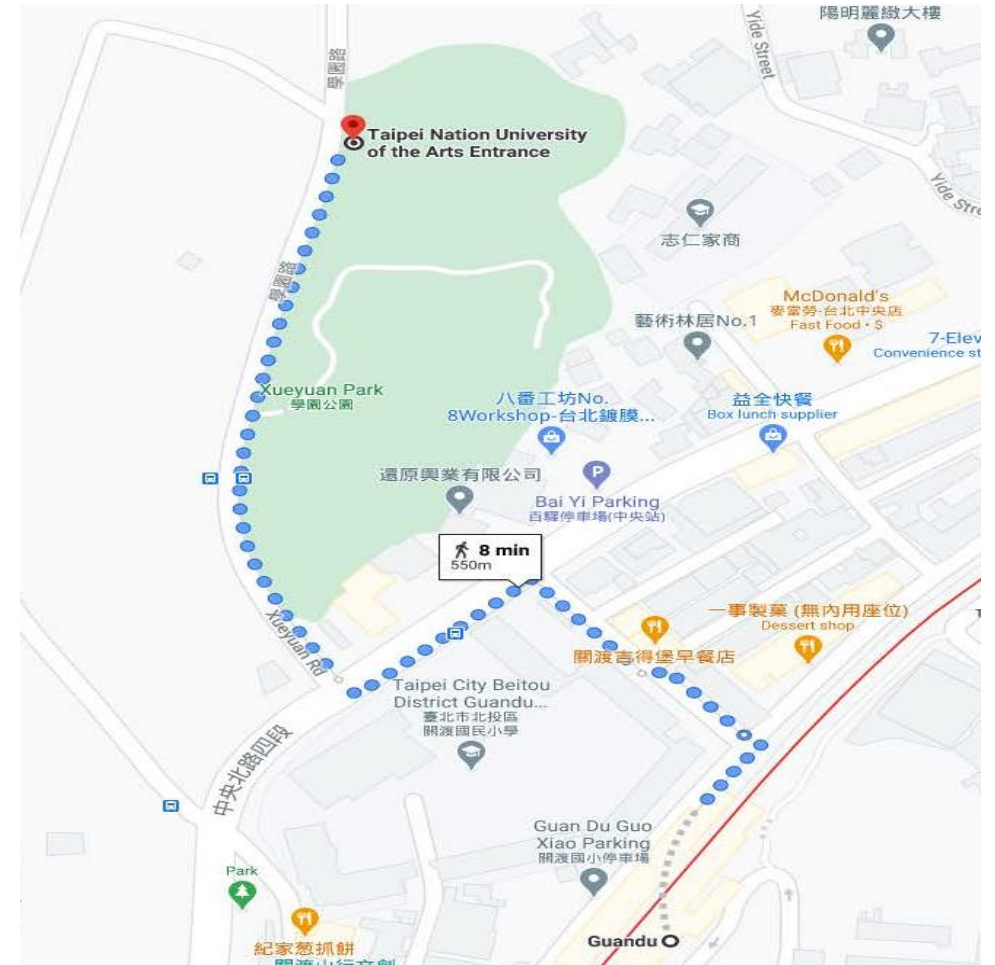
Next to metro station

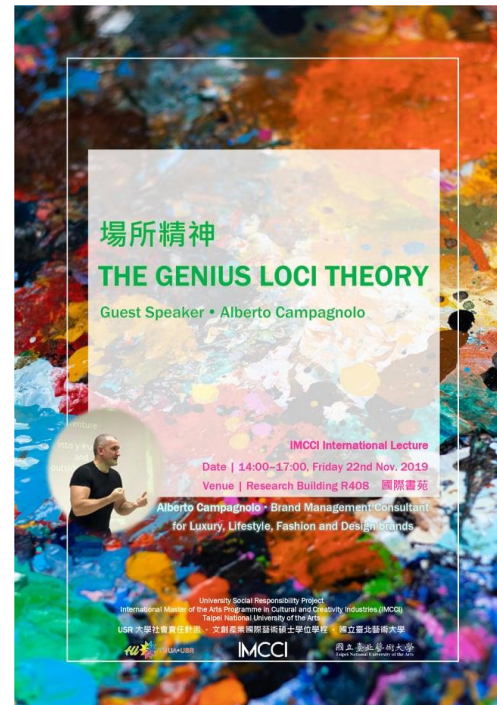
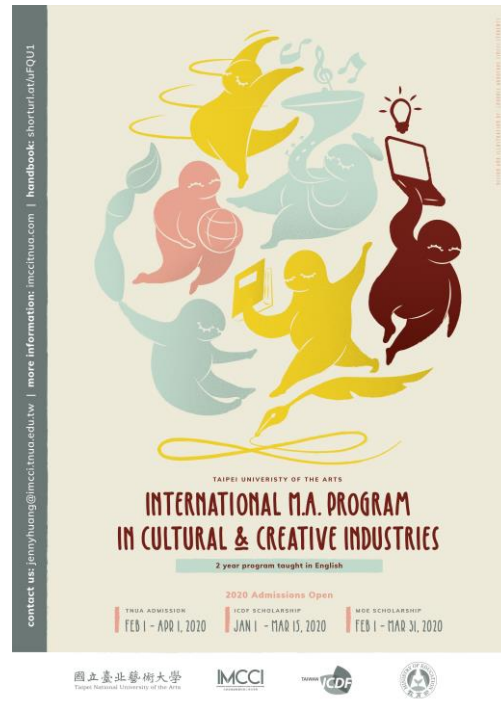
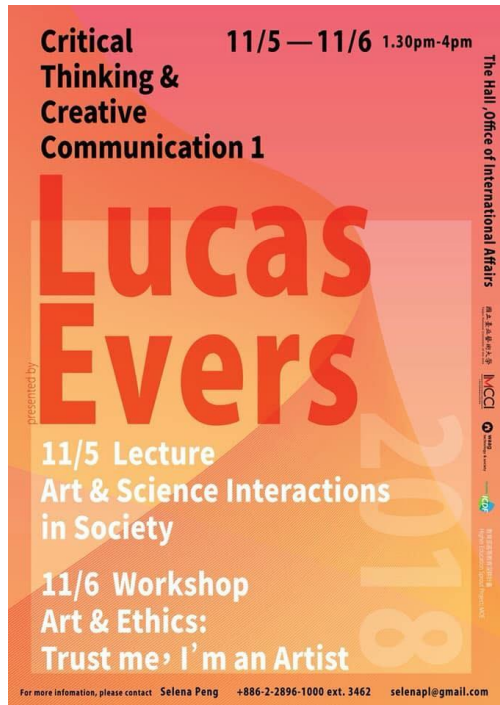


English Program

- International M.A. Program in Cultural and Creative Industries (IMCCI)
- A unique interdisciplinary graduate program.
- Founded in 2011, IMCCI is the only English-taught program in Taipei offering full scholarship within the context of a comprehensive arts university, boasting international faculty and state-of-the-art facilities.
- Offer seminars and workshops on the latest concepts and practical experience in the field in order to prepare students for a career in the arts.



- A Program for Critical Thinkers and Creative Professionals in Art and Cultural Industries
- While IMCCI belongs to the School of Cultural Resources, you'll have opportunities to take elective courses across the university, with access to TNUA's seven Schools: Music, Fine Arts, Theatre Arts, Dance, Film and New Media, Cultural Resources, and Humanities. You'll also be able to participate in the "Shared Campus" program, a cooperation platform for international education formats and research networks launched by seven arts institutions in Hong Kong, Singapore, Kyoto, Lon-don, and Zurich.
- It is specifically designed for the arts and culture sector, providing research training in contemporary arts and performance, and equipping students with art management strategies for art industries worldwide.
- It is built around 3 key areas: Arts and Humanities Core Theories, Arts and Contemporary Issues, and their application in Knowledge of International Business Management theories and practice. Using a variety of critical frameworks, you'll investigate contemporary visual and performing arts in both Taiwanese and international contexts, and engage with such pertinent topics as global Indigeneity, the Anthropocene, and the relationship between art and social engagement. We also provide applicative learning opportunities in subjects ranging from curatorial practice to arts management.

Performance and Exhibition Facilities

Experimental Theatre

- It is a multi-style theatre that can be adjusted to offer a proscenium stage, an open stage, or a center stage, catering to different styles of production in relation to the audiences.
- Capacity: 362 seats

Concert Hall

- It is designed for classical music, with state-of-the-art facilities.
- It houses a handmade pipe organ by Karl Schuke offering internationally accepted quality of sounds that can delight each and every one in the audience.
- Capacity: 500

Dance Theatre

- A proscenium stage specifically for dance performances, the Dance Theatre features wooden floorings carefully designed for the safety of dancers.
- The special side lights of the stage are designed for professional dance performances.
- Capacity: 344 seats

Movie Theatre

- Inside the Arts and Activity Complex that stands on the Egret Grassland, there is a 200-seat movie theatre with Dolby sound systems for screening 35mm films.
- It is meant for students and teachers to showcase and enjoy films of their own and others.

Kuandu Museum

- As the first-ever on-campus museum in Taiwan, the Kuandu Museum of Fine Arts houses nine exhibition rooms. Floor space, both indoor and outdoor, totals 25,920 square feet to serve multiple purposes:
 - 1. showing
 - 2. creative artworks
 - 3. practicing critical reviews
 - 4. organizing exhibitions
 - 5. promoting education and housing arts collections.



TNUA Arts Bookshop

- The TNUA Arts Bookshop was the first to be created and managed by a university in Taiwan.
- It offers mainly arts titles, as well as other books of literature and liberal arts.
- There is an audio-video section, with listening stations.
- The artistic interior offers unique ambience.

Athletic Field

- An excellent place for sports surrounded by cherry tree forest.

Egret Grassland

Scholarships for International Students

Before coming to Taiwan . . .

MOE/MOFA Taiwan Scholarship

- **Financial assistance:**
Waiver of tuition and certain fees of NT\$40,000. A monthly stipend of NT\$15,000 for undergraduate program students, and NT\$20,000 for postgraduate students.
- **Duration:**
Undergraduate program: four years maximum. Master's program: two years maximum. Doctoral program: four years maximum. Maximum duration for any combination of programs under this scholarship: five years.
- **Application period:**
February 1 to March 31, 2021.

ICDF Scholarship-for IMCCI program's students

- **Financial assistance:**
A monthly stipend of NT\$15,000. Cover tuition and credit fee as required by the school.
- **Application period:**
January 1 to March 15, 2021.

After coming to Taiwan . . .

TNUA Scholarship for International Students

- **Qualification:**
 - Undergraduate students who have completed two semesters, obtained a grade point average of at least 75 points for the semester prior to that of the time of application, and have never received punishment from the school for the violation of school regulations.
 - Masters or doctoral students who have completed one semester, obtained a grade point average of at least 80 points for the semester prior to that of the time of application, and have never received punishment from the school for the violation of school regulations.
- Each student shall only receive a maximum amount of 3 grants (3 semesters).
- **Financial assistance:**
 - NT\$15,000~NT\$30,000 per time

- Undergraduate Program (TWD/Semester): NT\$60,000~ NT\$ 70,000
- Graduate Program: NT\$55,000~ NT\$ 80,000

Application Schedule

- **Application Period:**

February 1 to April 1, 2021

- **Application Deadline:**

Deadline is on April 1, 2021 (Postal submissions must be postmarked by April 1, 2021)

- **Admission Result Announcement:**

Middle of June, 2021

- **Admission/Non-admission Letters Sent to Applicants:**

Beginning of July, 2021

- **On-Site Registration:**

Beginning of September, 2021

- **Classes Begin:**

Middle of September, 2021



Application Procedure

- Please make sure that you are eligible to apply as an international student and your education background is qualified for the intended program.
- Fill in the Online Application System for International Student Admission in Chinese or English. Print out the Application Form, Check List and Declaration for International Students (3 pages in total).
- Prepare all required documents (including additional required documents by the individual department/institute to which the applicant intends to apply).
- The application packet must be submitted either in person or by express mail to the Office of International Affairs (must be postmarked by April 1, 2021).
- You will be notified via email when your application package has been received.



Eligibility-Academic Background

Academic Background Requirements-Bachelor's Programs

- Those with senior high school diploma
- Those who are expecting their senior high school diploma in the current academic year

Academic Background Requirement-Master's Programs

- Those with bachelor's degree
- Those who are expecting their bachelor's degree in the current academic year

Academic Background Requirement-Doctoral Programs

- Those with master's degree
- Those who are expecting their master's degree in the current academic year

***Undergraduate program applicants should provide high school diploma and transcript.**

***Master's program applicants should provide bachelor's degree diploma and transcript.**

***Doctoral program applicants should provide master's degree diploma and transcript.**



Language Requirement

Most courses are conducted in Chinese. Applicants are expected to have sufficient listening, speaking, reading and writing ability in Chinese language. Language requirements may differ from program to program. If required otherwise, the applicants should follow the individual requirements demanded by the intended departments or graduate programs.
